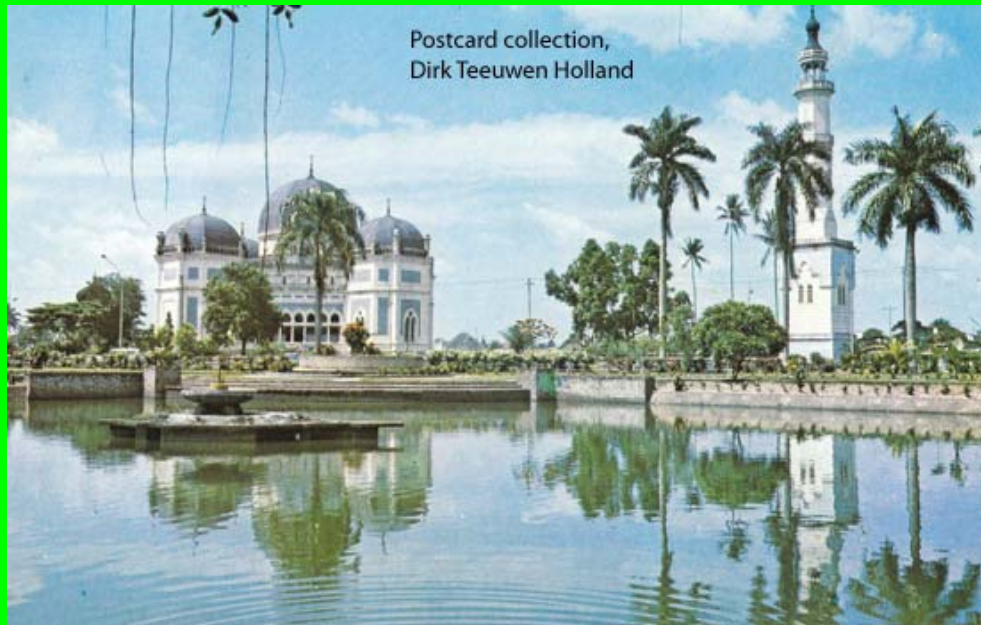
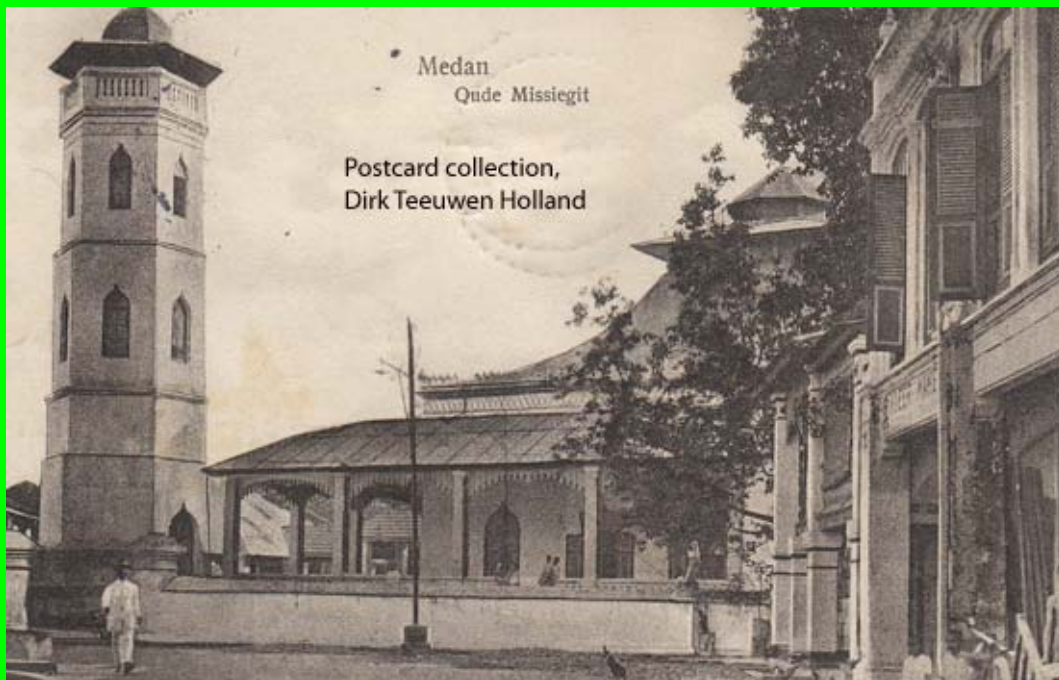


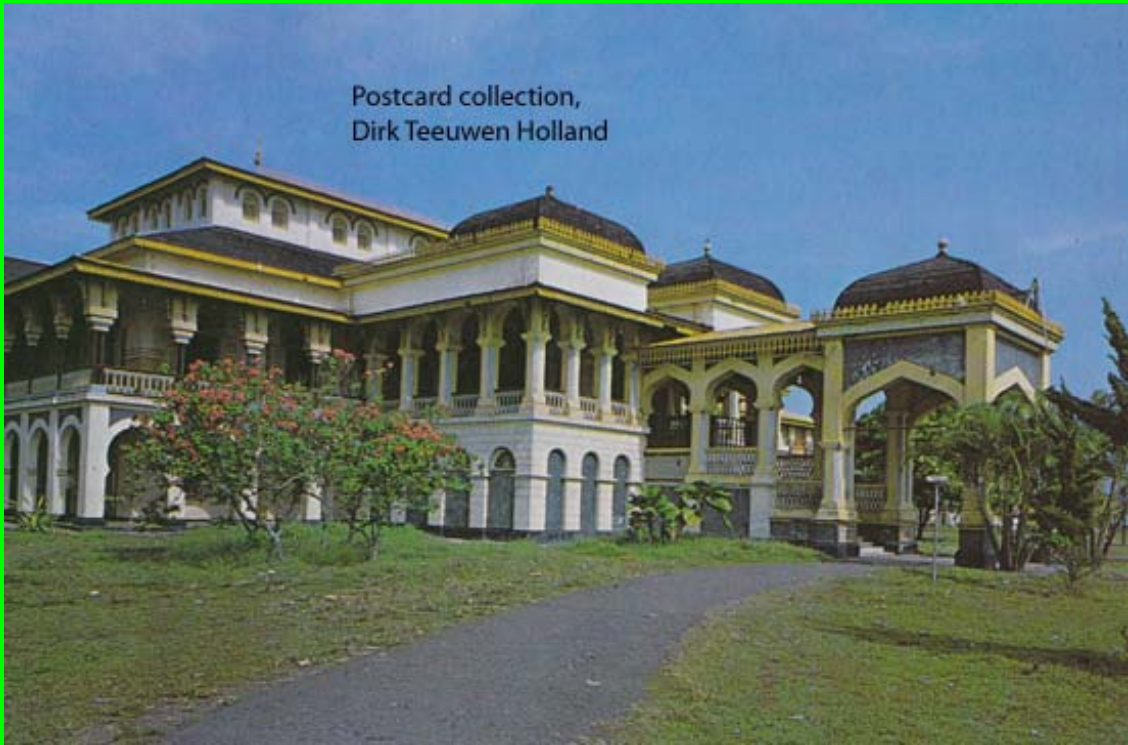

1. Mesjid Raya, Grand Mosque; Medan (North Sumatra) 1972

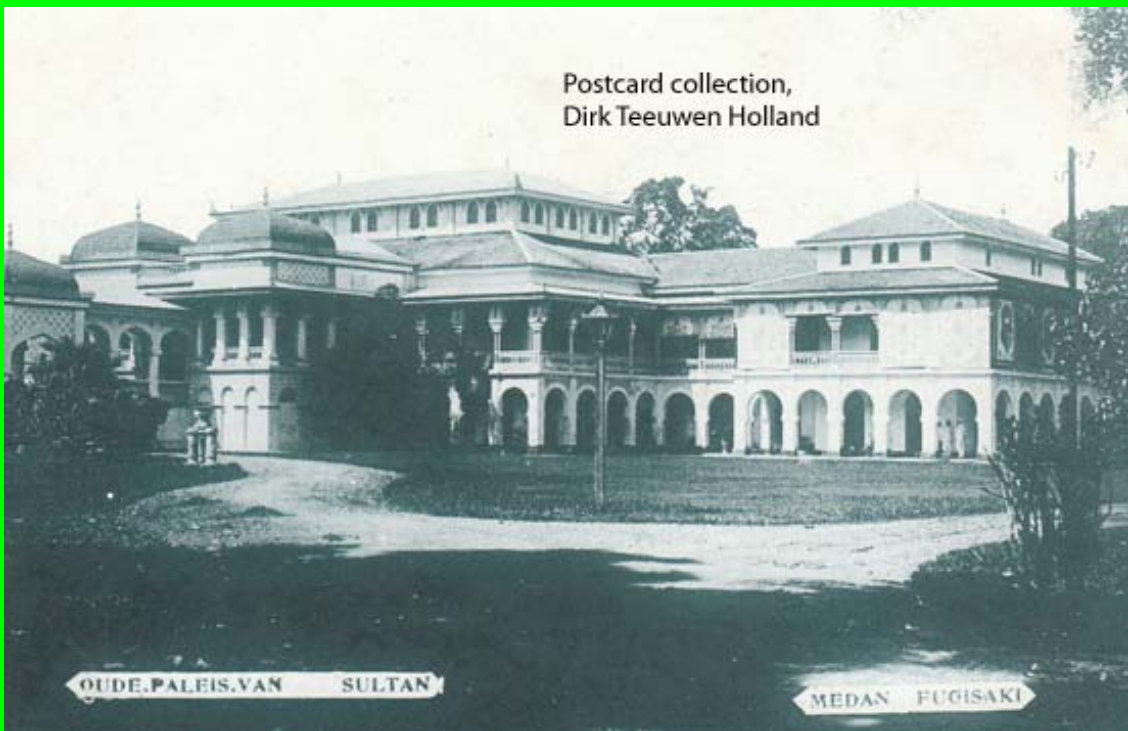


2. The old mosque; Medan 1922



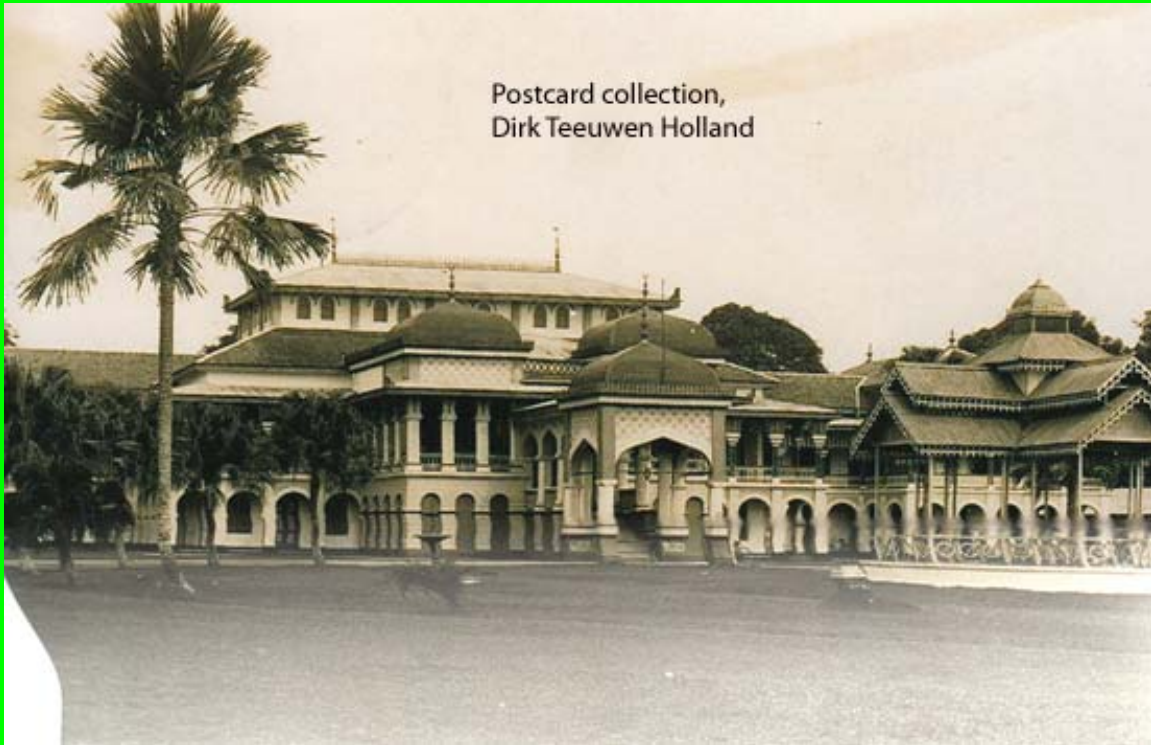

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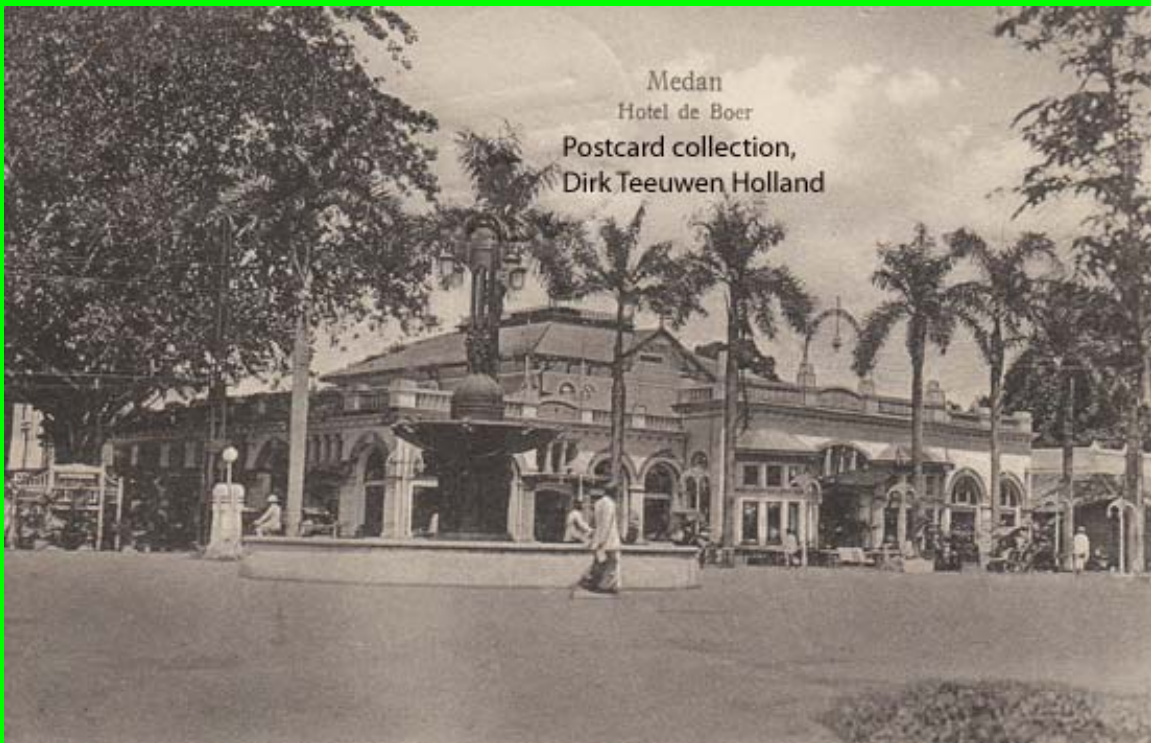
8. Colonial Deli planters having a Hari Besar party in the White Club; Medan 1936

Hari Besar means party or, better, celebration day. Plantation companies paid their staff once in a fortnight, on Wednesdays. Those days were big party days with too much food and much too much beer as well as gin.

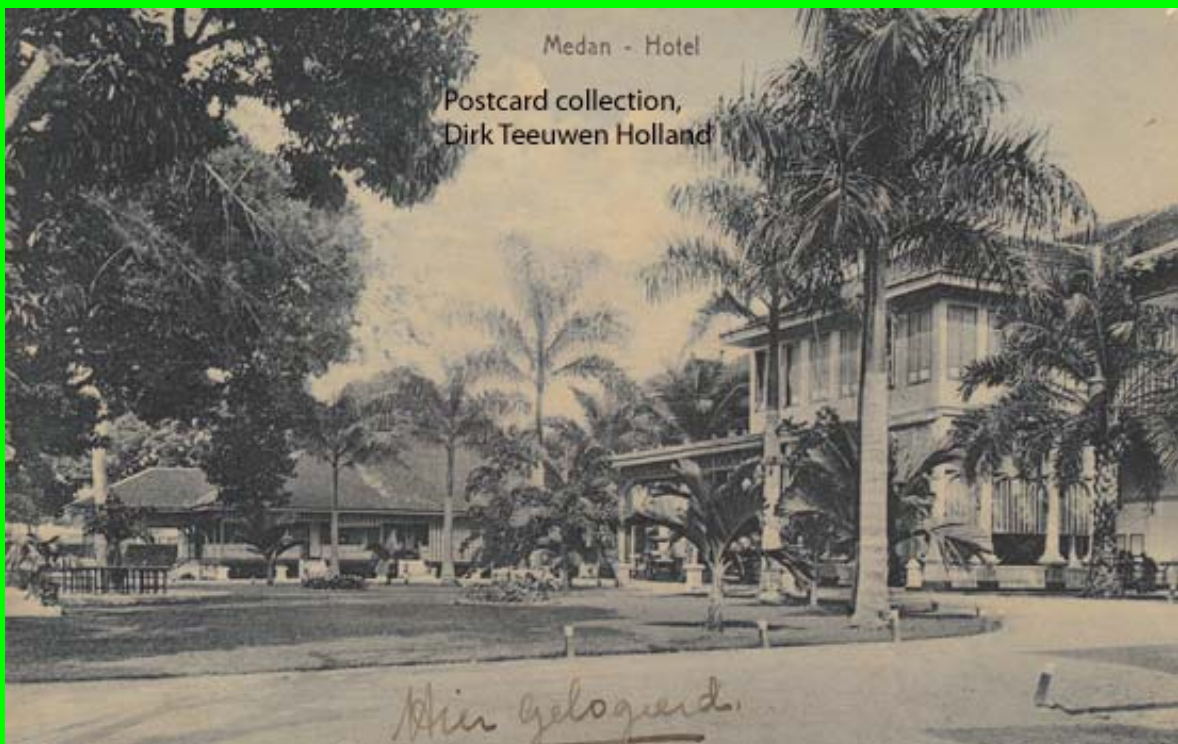

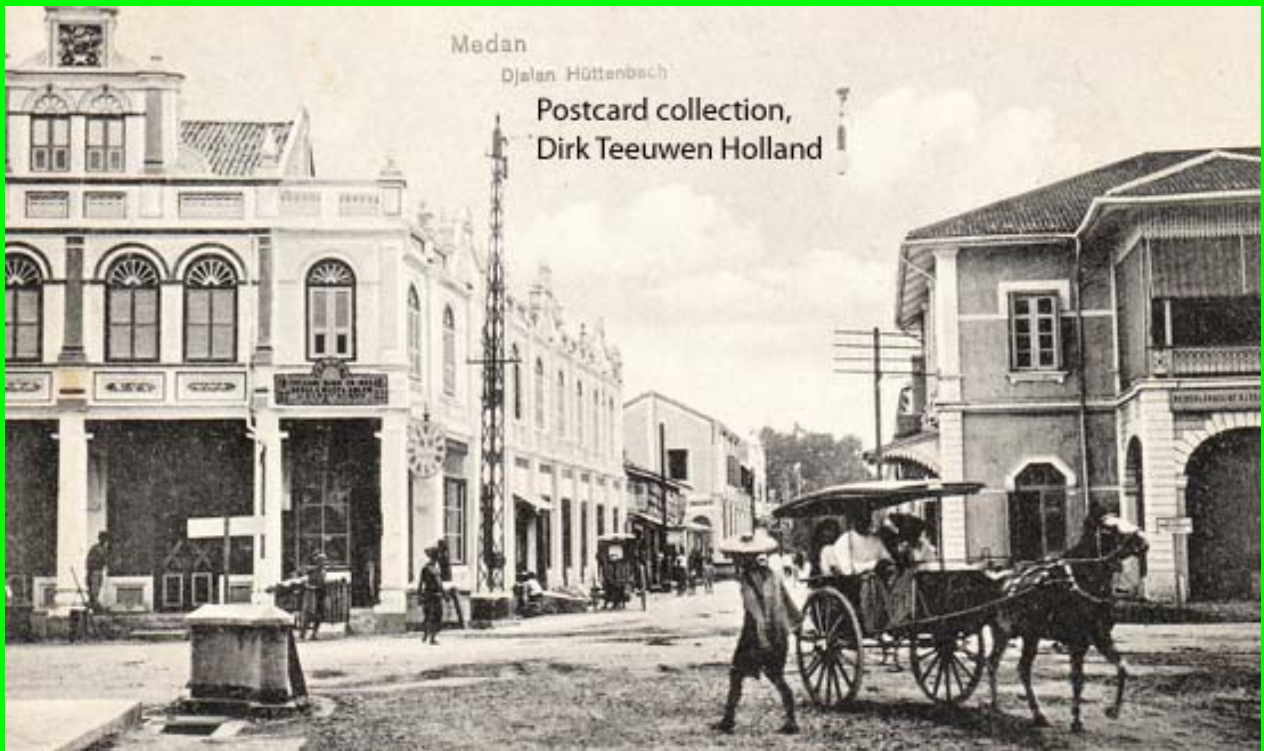




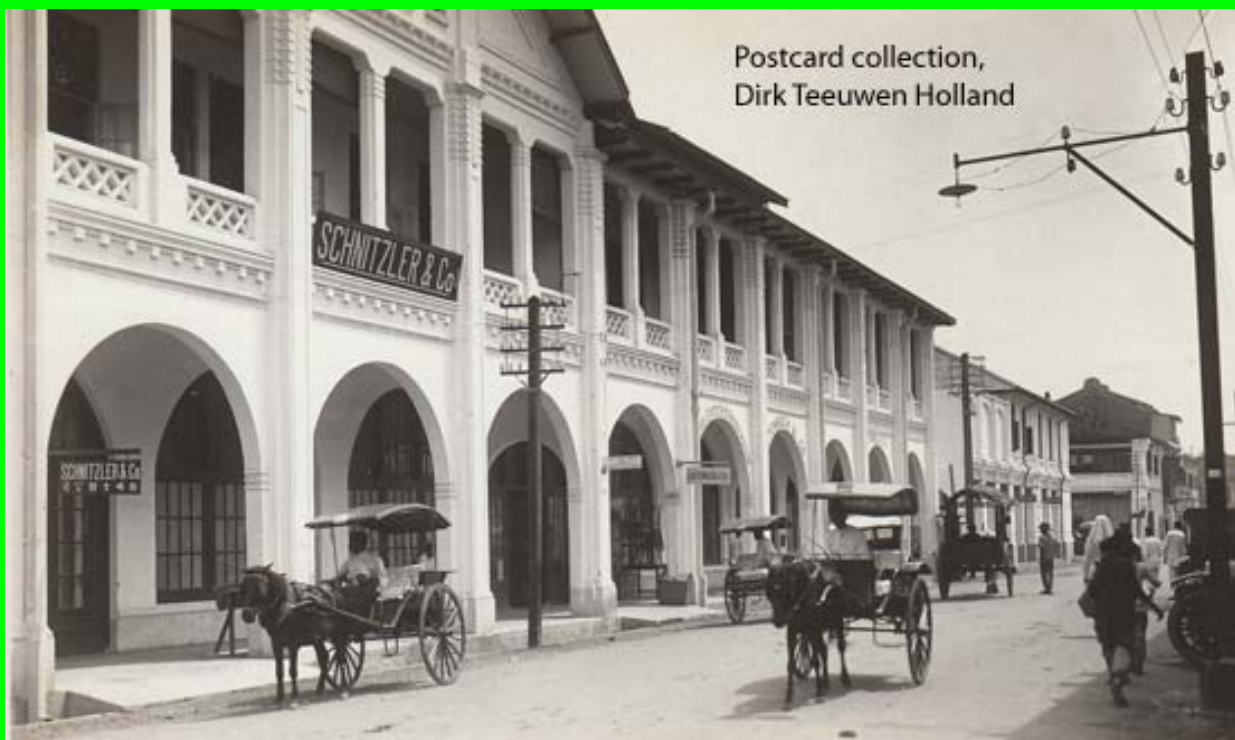
17. The resident's residence along Poloniaweg (Polonia Road), now Jl Imam Bonjol; Medan 1919
 The main building, left, is still there. Now an office of the Chartered Bank. The "country side atmosphere" has gone completely.



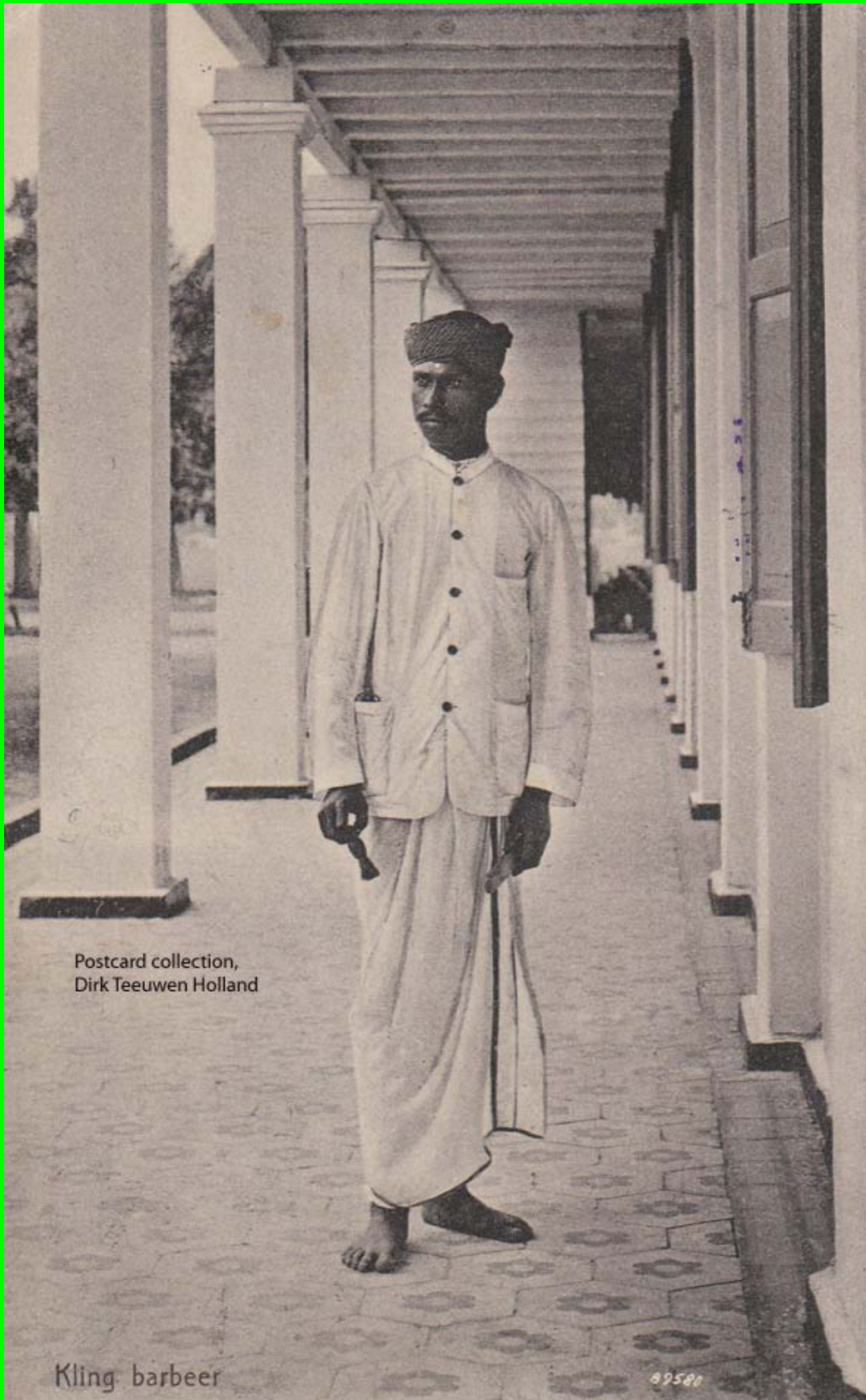
18. The main Post Office, location across Hotel De Boer now Hotel Dharma Deli; Medan circa 1925
