1. Grand Hotel Java along Rijswijk (JI Veteran), Batavia- Jakarta circa 1890

Grand Hotel Java was a private residence until 1834. The hotel was demolished in 1958. On the same location one can find Markas Besar TNI Angkatan Darat (the Headquarters of the Indonesian Army) nowadays. Batavia counted three leading hotels: Hotel Des Indes, Hotel der Nederlanden and Grand Hotel Java. The latter stood on a parcel about one kilometre east from Hotel der Nederlanden / the Palace. This parcel stretched from Rijswijk (JI Veteran) to Koningsplein (Medan Merdeka), comparable with the parcel of Hotel der Nederlanden (now Bina Graha, Presidential Office).
