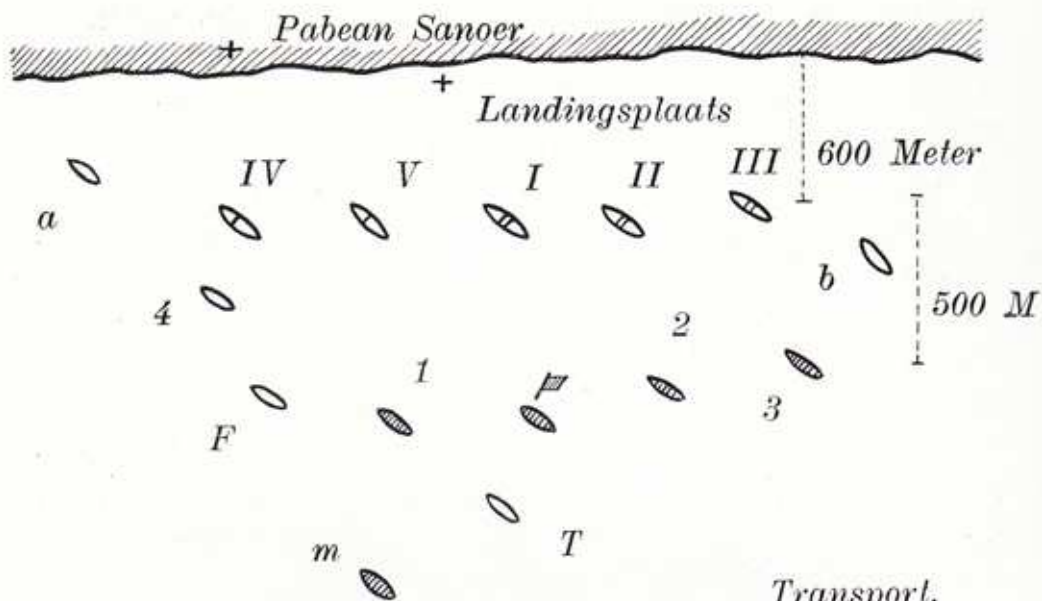

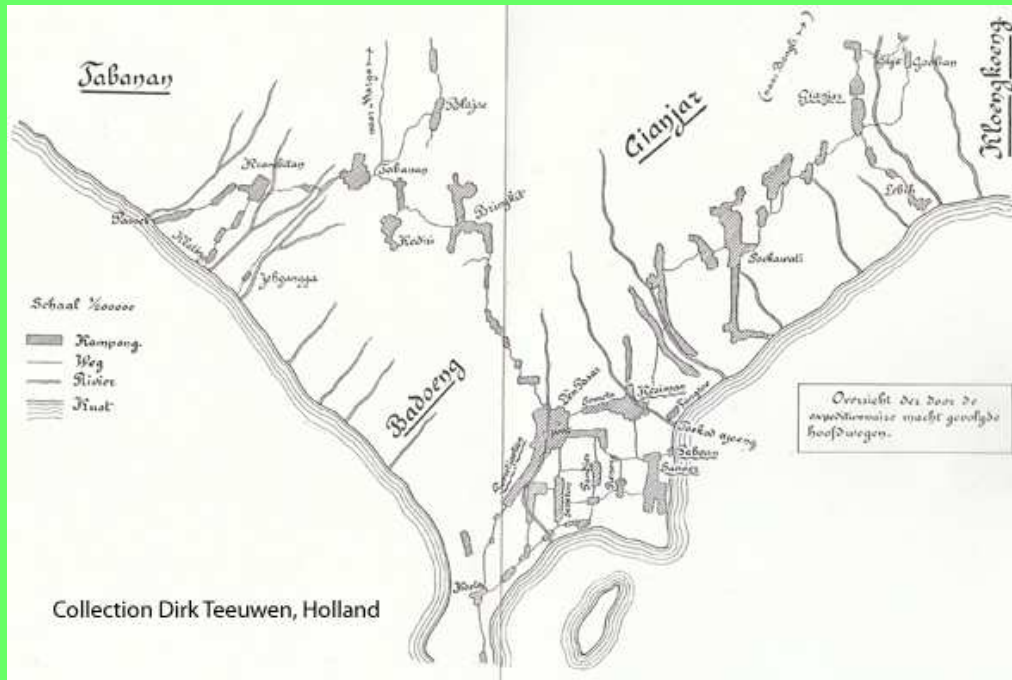

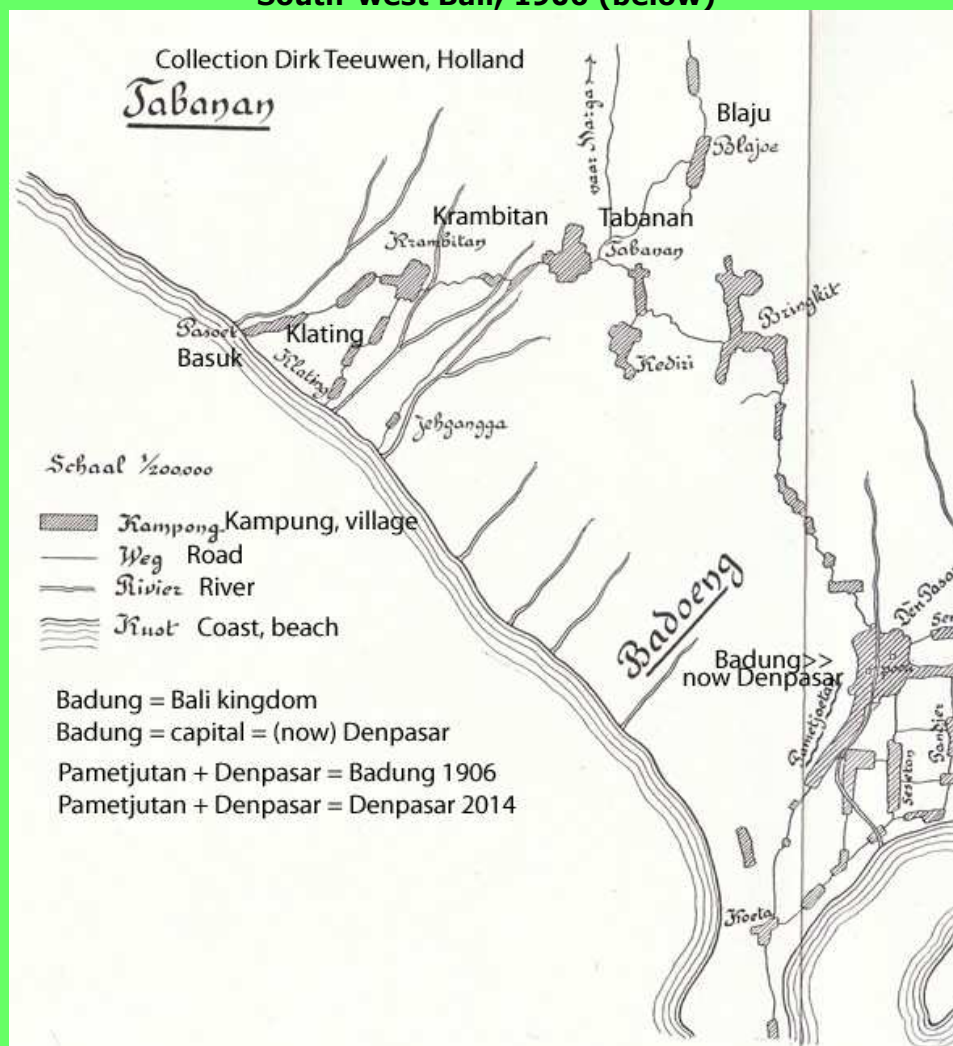

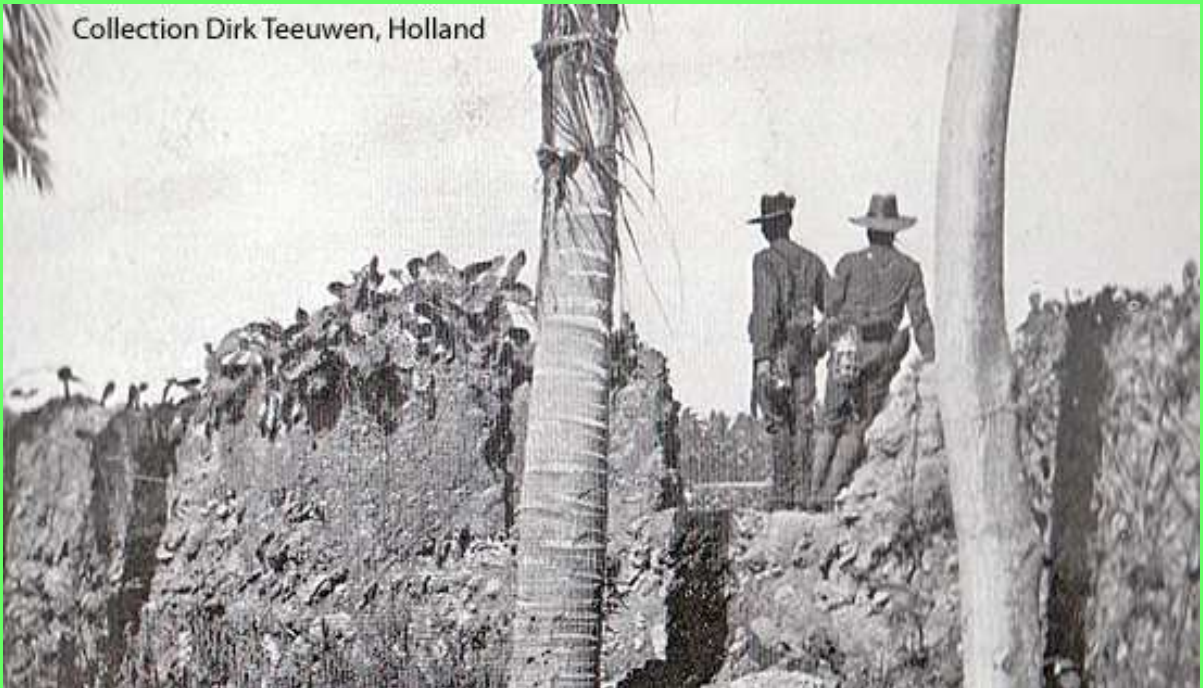

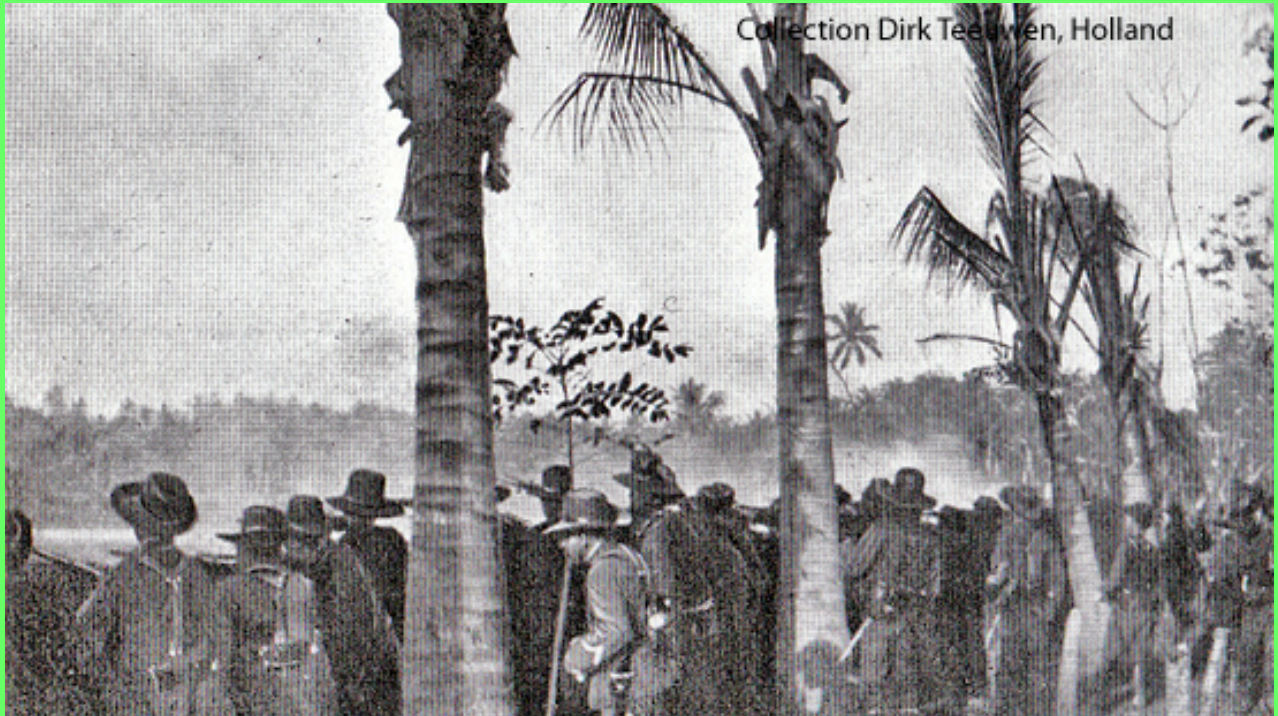

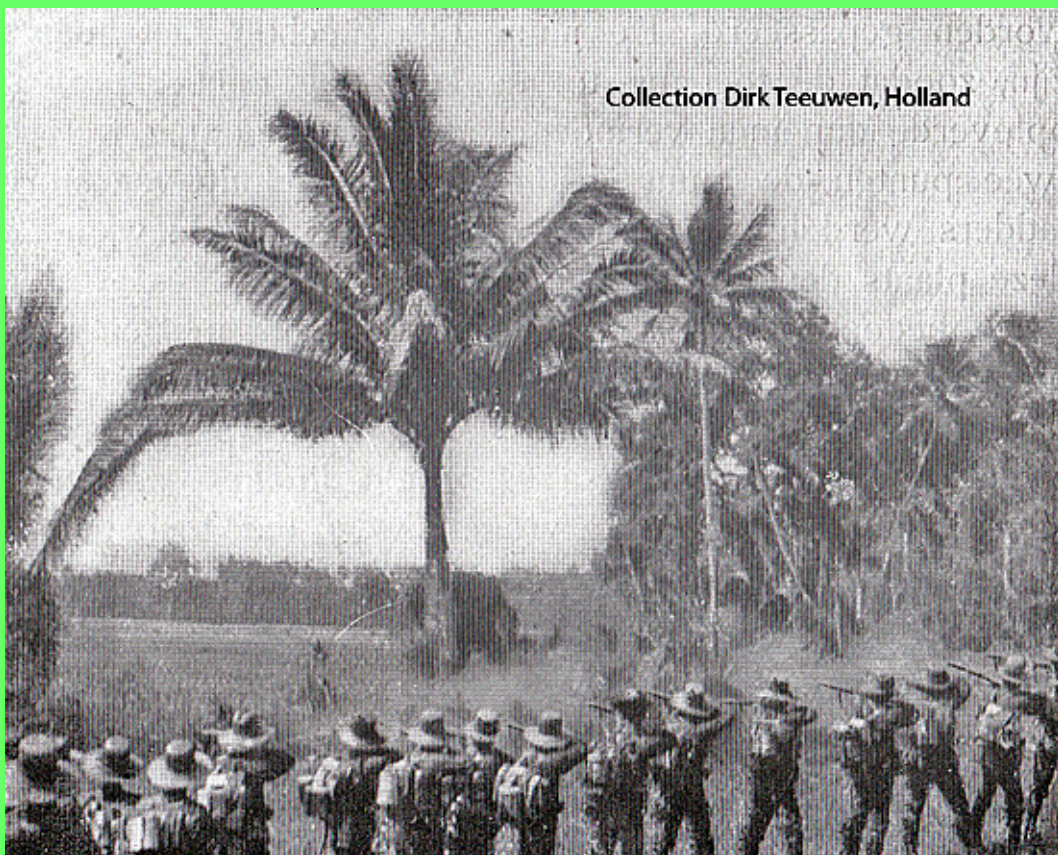

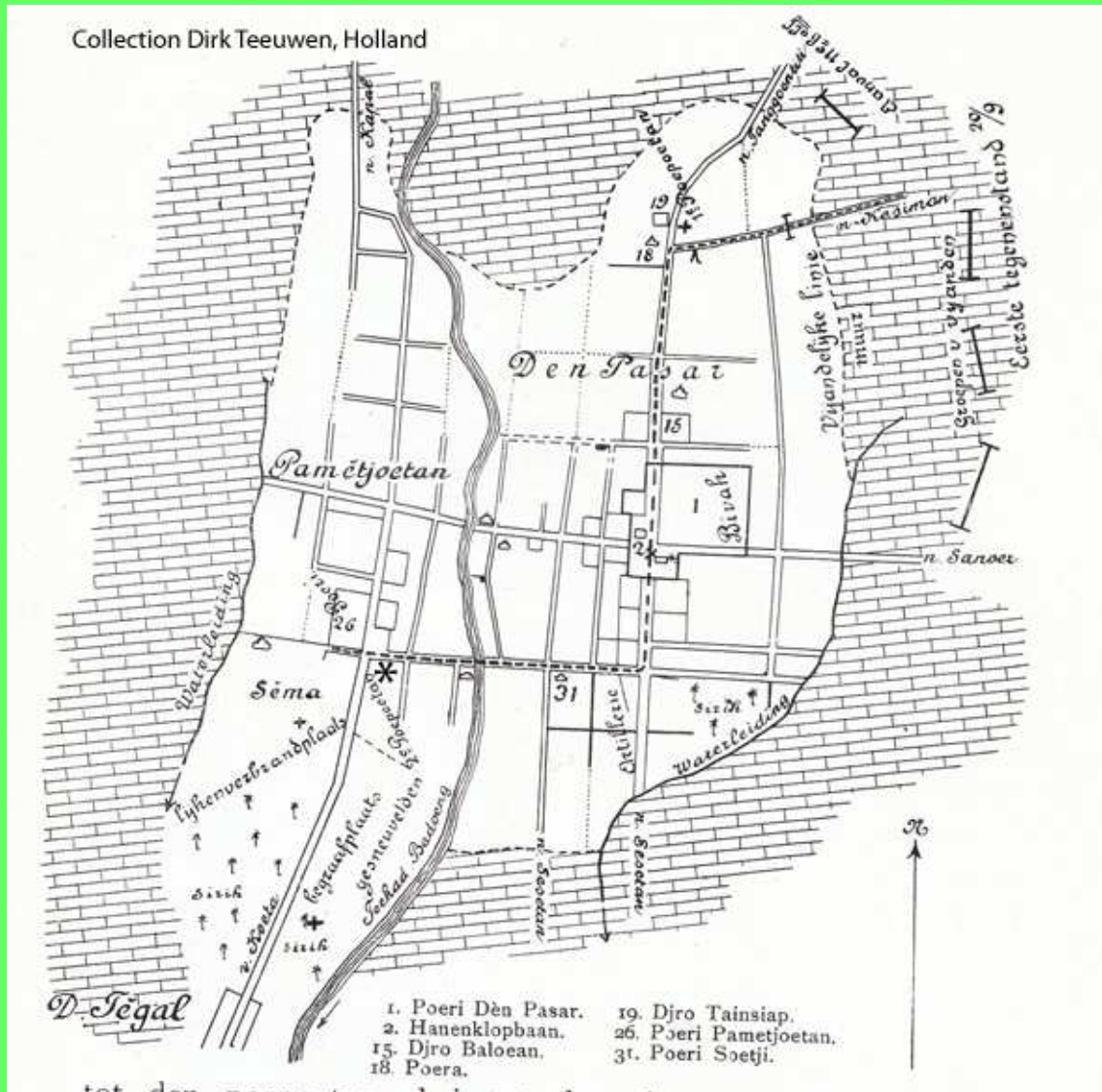

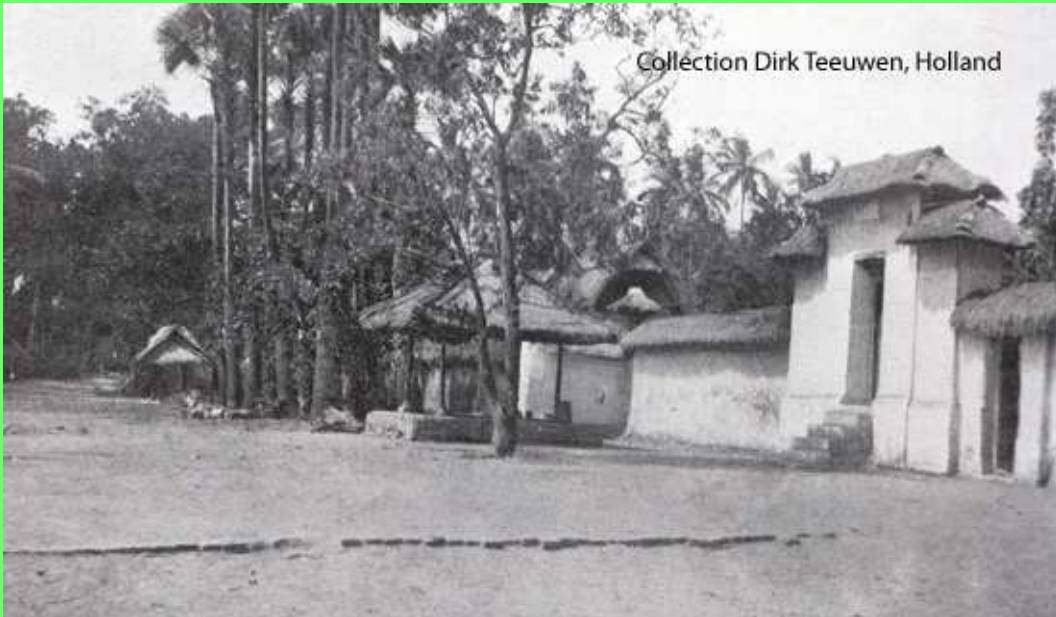


Map, Badung Capital, quarters Denpasar and Pamecutan; now Denpasar, Bali 1906
